Christelle Abou Chakra is dead. Before her, Manal Assi died, and before her, Fatima Bakkour and Roula Yaacoub died too. And so did Malika, and Adel, and Baghdad, and Bouthayna, and Mona, and Sonia, and Niliane, and Amina, and Latifa... The list is growing with names that had faces, lives, desires, dreams and fears; all gone when he decided so. All it took is for him to decide to kill her and no one there to stop him.

He is today ready to kill one more woman, and another one after that. He threatens us, poisons us, grabs our hair, throws us on the ground, rips our clothes, burns our bodies, and claims our souls. We were the first ones to become familiar with the most dangerous "security threats" in the country.

And all of this without the protection of our own parliament, even after it extended its own term, supposedly due to our country's security situation, while our own security within our own homes is never guaranteed. And every day, the fear of losing our mothers, sisters, friends, neighbors, and strangers eats us alive.

Nine months have passed since the Lebanese Parliament decided to extend its own term, and yet to this day it hasn't decided on a law that would acknowledge the violence we suffer from as women, nor has it even set forth the necessary protection measures to save us from a possible death. To them, we were not – and are not – worthy of the “priority” title, which they assure us every day, is out of reach for every Manal, Christelle, and Roula among us.

Things couldn't be worse, and we can no longer wait for the death of another woman to make them realize that we are in real danger. We can no longer wait to revolt against the darkness and fill the streets with our rage.

So let's take our screams to the streets and demand that Parliament Speaker calls for a legislative session and pass the law to protect women from family violence with the necessary adjustments.
